2009-2010 Academic Year**

Graduate applicants must certify that they have at least \$29,573.00 for each twelve-month period of study. Certification of the first year's funds is required. If the applicant plans to bring his/her family, \$6,500.00 for the spouse and \$4,500.00 for each child must be certified in addition to the \$29,573.00.
