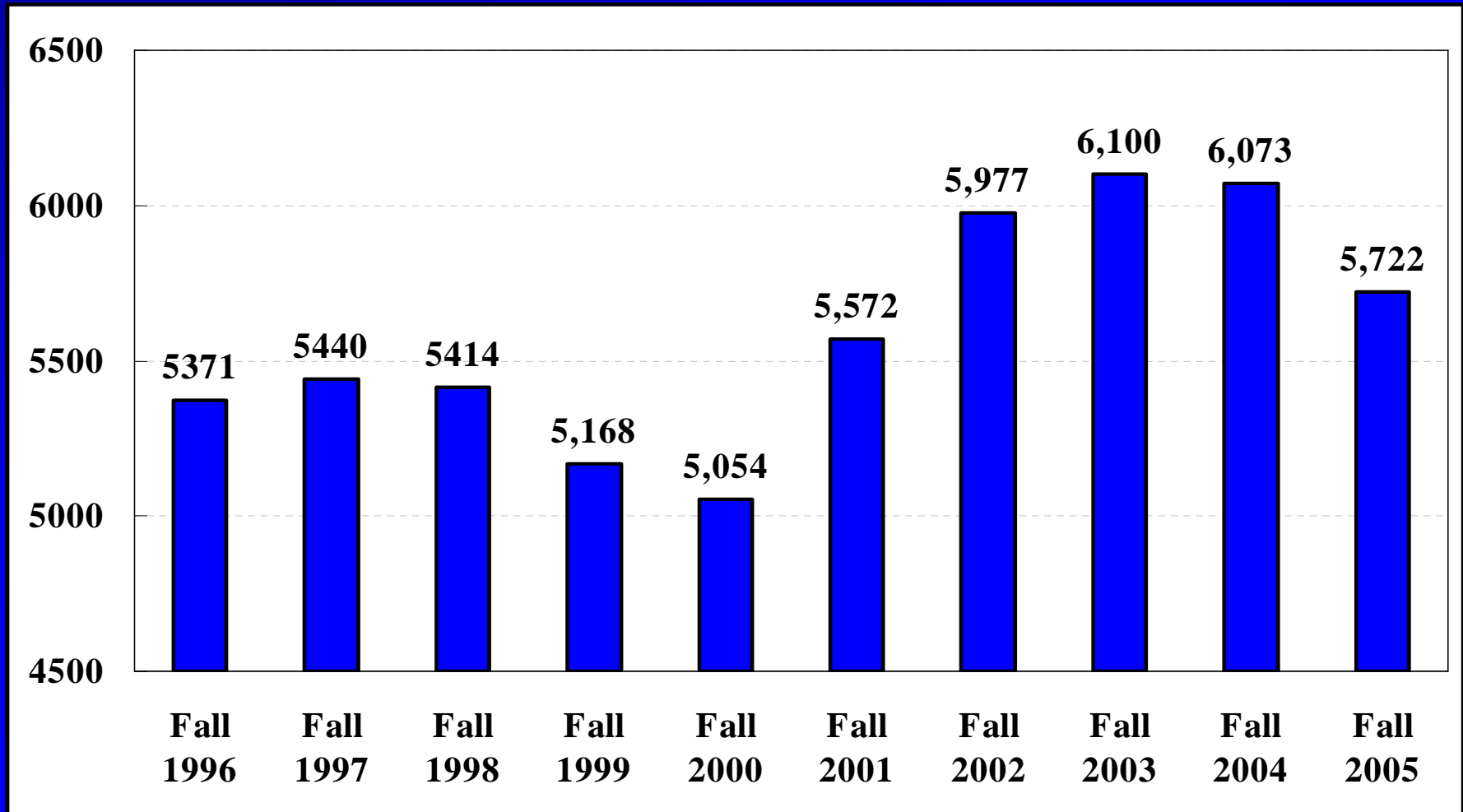

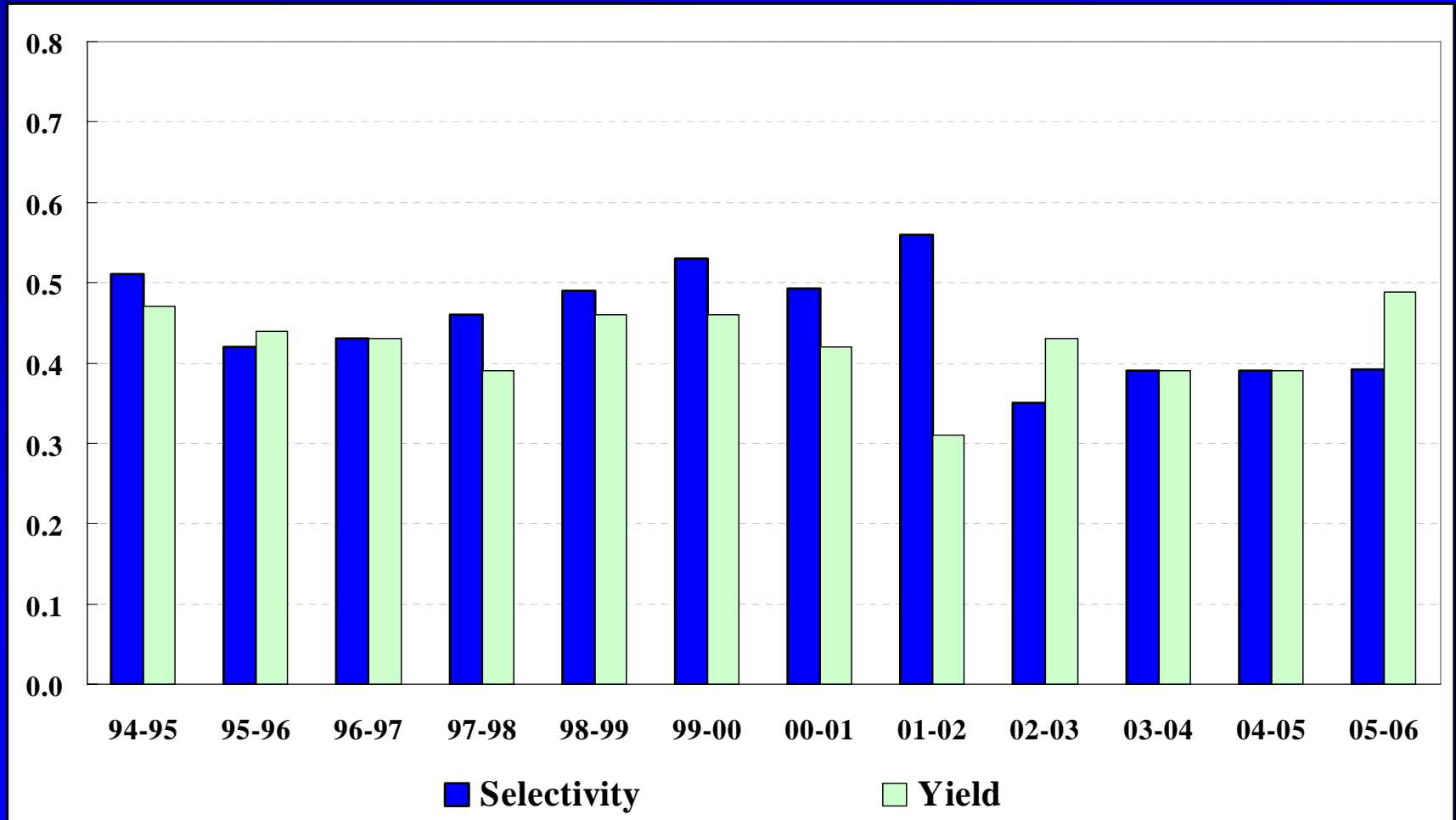

Doctoral Selectivity & Yield



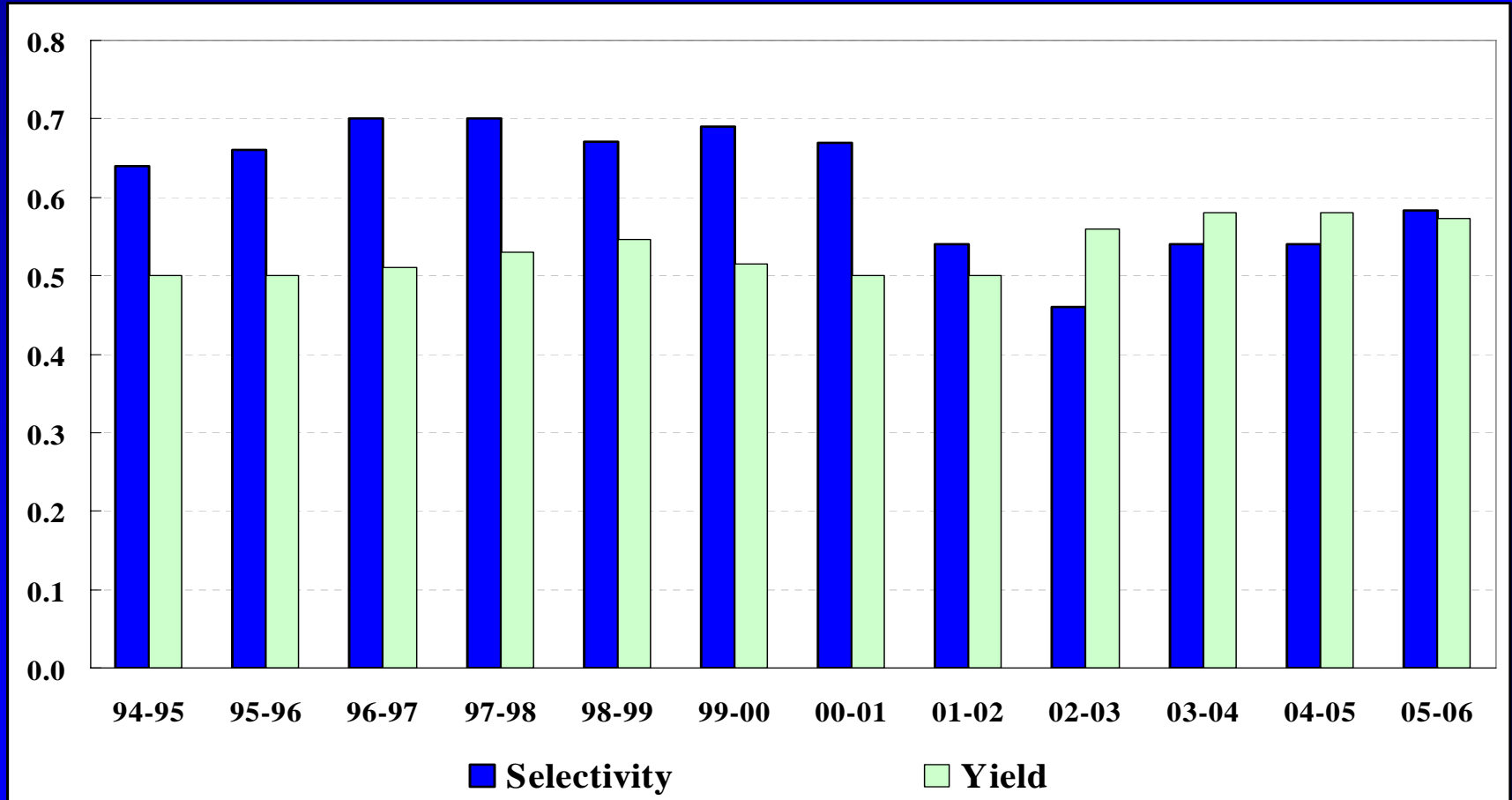

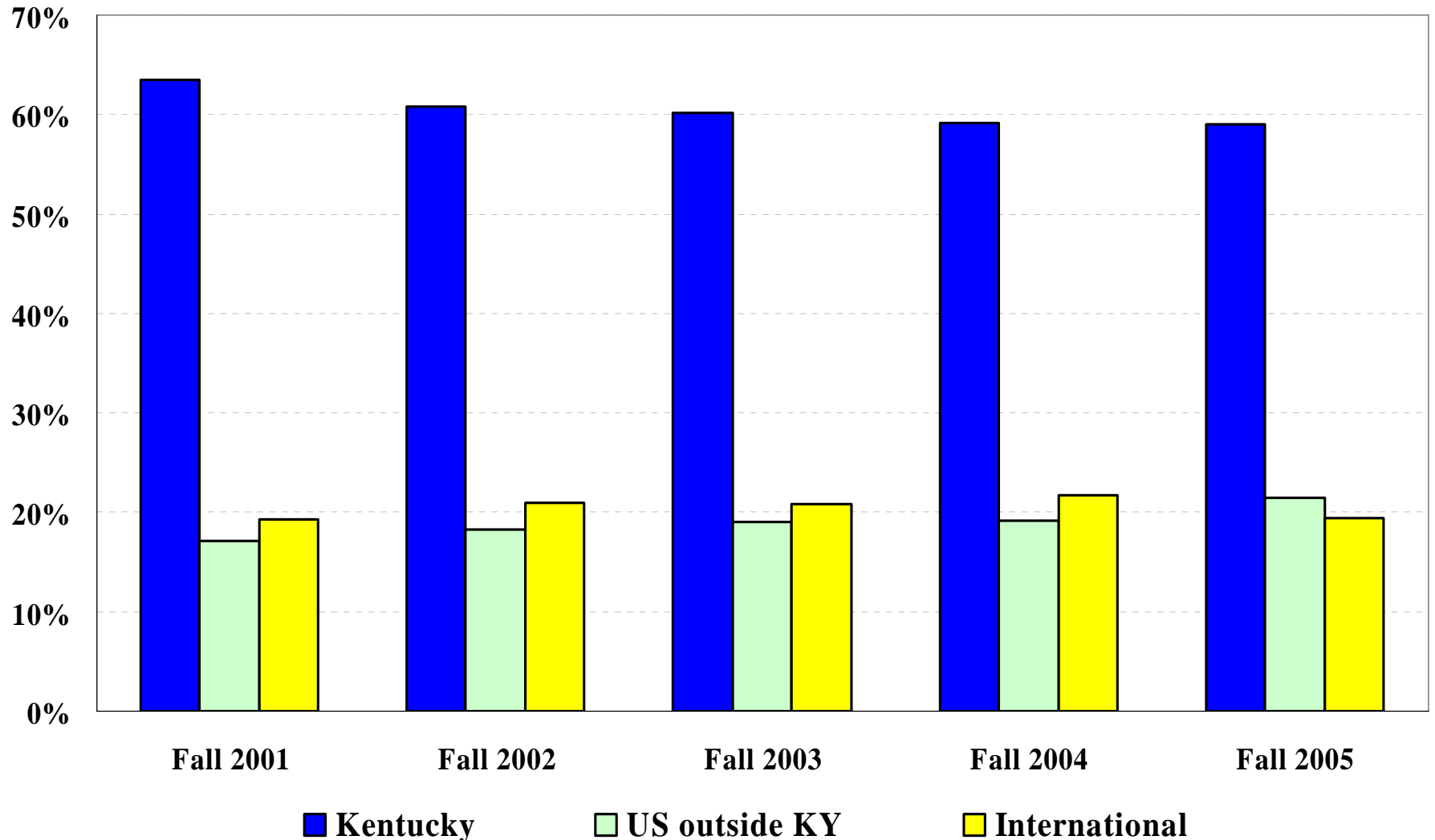

Fall 2005 Graduate Enrollment by Residency



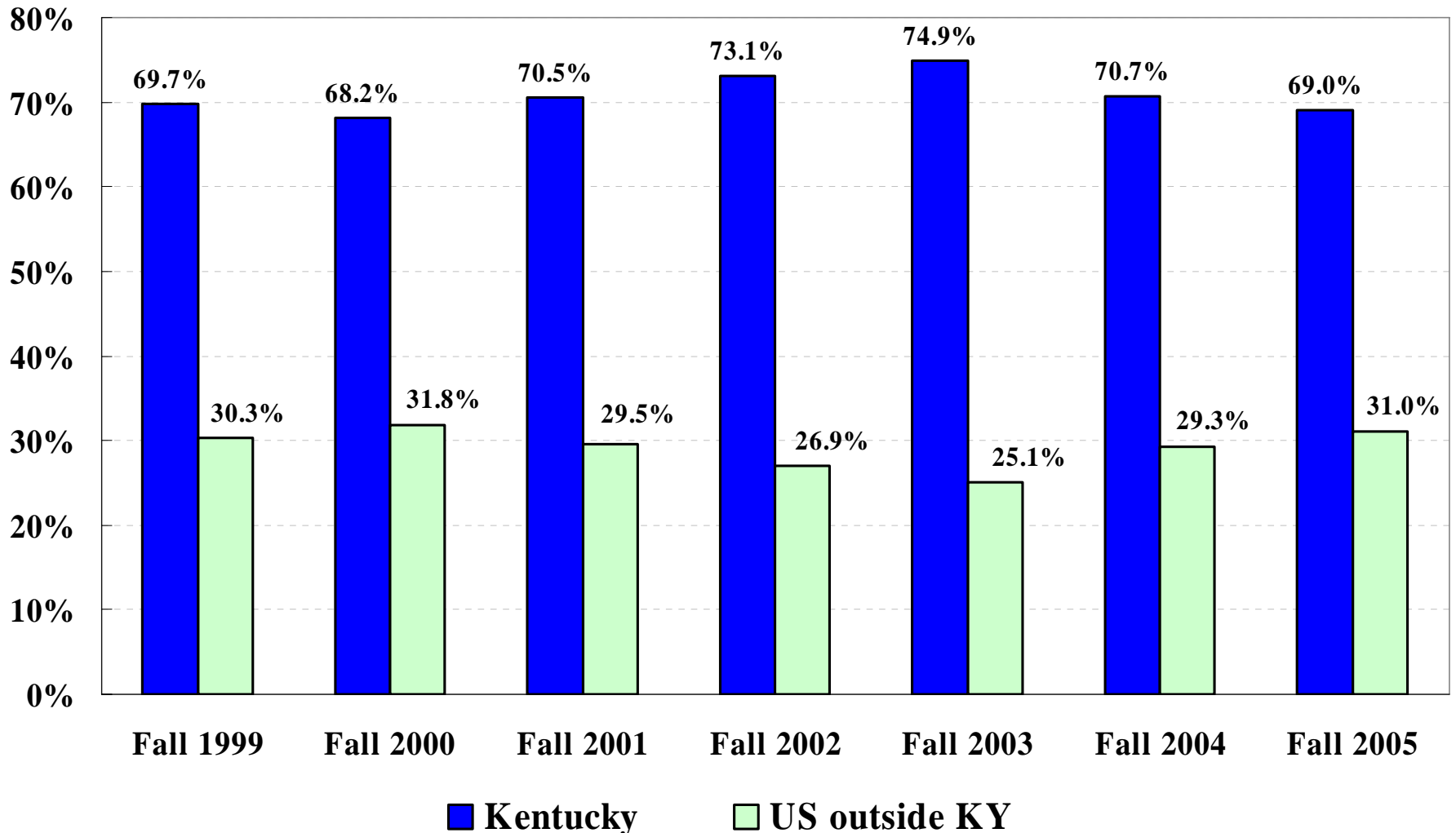
