1. A completed fellowship application form specific to the UK Woman's Club Fellowship.
2. A resume or curriculum vitae
3. Two letters of recommendation prepared by faculty familiar with the candidate's academic abilities
4. An essay of no more than two double-spaced pages, providing information to the committee in evaluating the candidate's application. This information might include area of concentration within the field of study, obstacles overcome, aspirations, personal characteristics, and how a candidate might benefit from this fellowship.

Please note the student's name and the name of the fellowship in the subject line of your email (only one copy of each item is necessary if submitted by email).

1. Transcripts from all schools attended, both undergraduate and graduate
2. Official GRE or GMAT scores
