

Has it been three (3) years since you took human subjects protection training?

If so, update your human subjects protection training in order to be able to continue your research activities that involve human subjects.

The UK Human Subject Protection training mandate dictates that study personnel complete continuing education at least every three (3) years.

There are several options for renewing your human subjects protection training:

1. The web based CITI human subjects protection training (refresher course option). Enter the CITI website and register as a UK user. The course is a synopsis of the main biomedical or social/behavioral modules that are required as initial training. 2. The web based VA Good Clinical Practice and Human Subjects Protection modules (submit certificate to ORI at completion) Web address: <https://www.citiprogram.org/default.asp>
3. If you attend the UK annual conference (Schulman) on human subjects protection, and have a certificate from that training, it will satisfy the requirement.
4. If you have attended a human subjects protection program (ex. PRIM&R) within the last six (6) months, and have a certificate from that training, it may satisfy the requirement (this does not include an isolated session on human subjects protection as part of a conference on another subject matter).
5. The web based NIH human subjects protection program (only qualifies as a refresher course and not for initial human subjects protection training). Web address: http://cme.cancer.gov/c01/intro_01.htm
6. Register and attend selectively identified UK ORI conferences (to be announced).
